



Where to Enjoy Outdoor Dining for Chicago Patio Season

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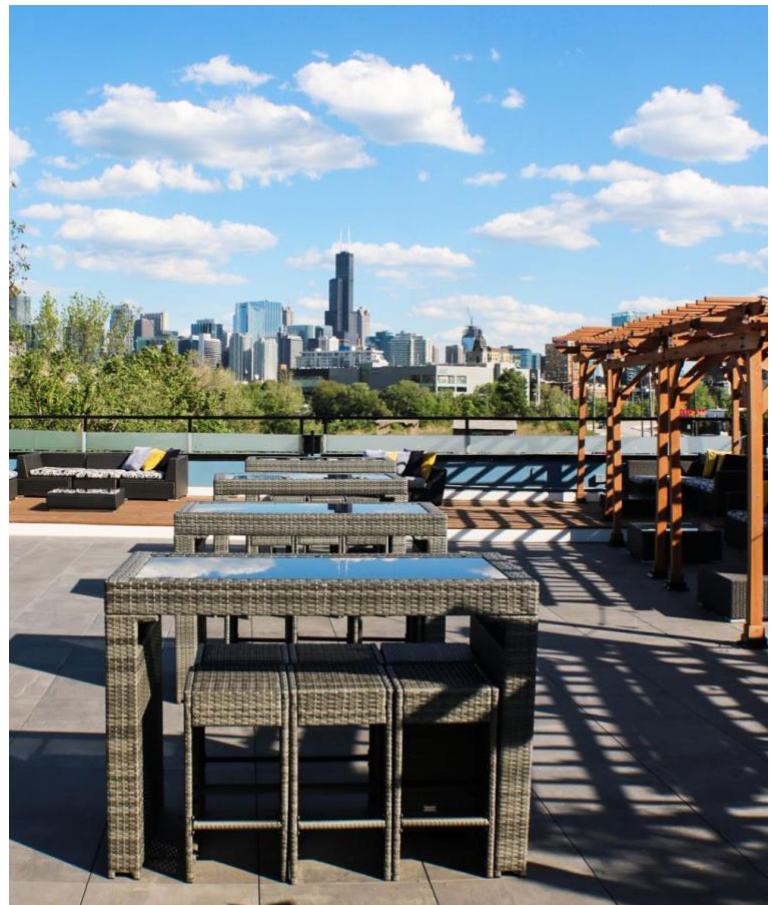
Spring is here and it's been absolutely gorgeous outside which means it's time for patio season in Chicago and the surrounding area! Soak in the sun and fresh air at your favorite restaurants:

Cielo (Goose Island)

Cielo Rooftop at Azul (1177 N. Elston Ave.) is now open with an open-air rooftop. The lofty venue will feature an array of seating for guests to choose from including lounge-style couches, cabanas with wooden pergolas and high-top seating.

Featuring cuisine crafted by Azul's chef Michael Hernandez, the seafood-forward menu will highlight Crudos, Ceviches, Tacos, and other lighter fare. Standout menu items will include:

- *Barco de Mariscos*
- a shareable Seafood Boat with Alaskan King Crab Leg, Lobster, Jumbo Shrimp, and Oysters served on ice with Cocktail Sauce, Mignonette, Lime, Hot Sauce, and Salt on the side.
- *Octopus Ceviche* - octopus cured in Citrus Juice, Cucumber, Avocado, Roasted Jalapeno & Serrano Peppers, Jicama, Red Onion, Cilantro
- *Ahi Tuna Tacos* - seared Sushi-grade Ahi Tuna, Avocado Cucumber Salsa, Frizzled Onion, Romaine Lettuce Cups, Mango



- *Trio of Mexican “Paletas”* - locally made Spicy Mango, Tamarind, and Strawberry Popsicles

A tropical beverage program of Frozen Cocktails, Cervezas, Hard Seltzers and signature drinks complement the Latin-inspired fare. The drink menu brims with sippers including Frozen Mangonada with Centenario Reposado, Mango Puree, Fresh Lime Juice, Chamoy and Lime; Topo Chico Hard Seltzer Cans in a variety of flavors and Azul’s famous Margaritas.

Bottle service offerings will also be available.

Cielo Rooftop at Azul will be open from Wednesday through Friday: 5pm - midnight; and Saturday through Sunday: noon - midnight. Table reservations are required for guaranteed seating.
